WASHINGTON, D.C., MAY 10, 1978 - The so-called "Supplementary Election" of the Legislative Yuan of 1975 produced a great number of political prisoners in Taiwan. The repressive Nationalist regime simply could not tolerate any quest for majority rule in Taiwan.

Pai Ya-tsan, a young lawyer, is the author of 29 questions of advice to Chiang Ching-kuo. These 29 questions were rejected in total by the regime, not because the advice contained elements of "subversion" - one of the charges against Pai - but because they collectively embarrassed Chiang Ching-kuo. Pai was seized in October, 1975 when he was distributing his campaign leaflets. After savage torture, he was sentenced to life imprisonment.

Huang Hua was the managing editor of the now defunct <u>Taiwan Political Review</u>. His eloquent appeal for majority rule through a process of peaceful change together with his active involvement in the Kuo Yu-hsin campaign for the Legislative Yuan was interpreted by the regime as a great threat to its own survival. Thanks to the enormous publicity abroad on Huang's case, Huang escaped torture. But he did not escape political imprisonment. He was given a ten-year term.

By 1975 Yen Ming-shen was a highly promising political star. With the active assistance of Yang Ching-hai, Yen overwhelmed his Kuomintang opponent in the race for the Legislative Yuan. Alarmed by Yen's rising popularity, the Nationalist regime resorted to vote fraud to defeat him. In order to eliminate the Yen/Yang combination once and for all, the regime decided to throw them into jail after savage torture. Yang, the master strategist for Yen's campaign, was sentenced to life imprisonment. Yen, the top vote-getter in his constituency, was sentenced to twelve years.

Pai, Huang, Yen, and Yang are now residents of "Green Island." A small, isolated islet off the east coast of Taiwan, Green Island is the most fearful tiger cage in the island of Taiwan. The residents here are mostly "incurable" prisoners of conscience such as Pai, Huang, Yen, and Yang.

The cases of Pai, Huang, Yen, and Yang were effectively presented in the June 24, 1977 hearing on Human Rights in Taiwan sponsored by the Subcommittee on International Organizations of the Committee on International Relations of the U.S. House of Representatives. The presentation was later incorporated in "Human Rights in Taiwan," a Congressional document available free of charge by writing to: Committee on International Relations, U.S. House of Representatives, Washington, D.C. 20515.
